KOTA KINABALU: Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) students who wish to return to home are allowed to do so.

According to Local Government and Housing Minister Datuk Seri Panglima Masidi Manjun who is also UMS chairman, the university has decided to allow the students to return since Nov 20.

He also said that they would have to present a letter from their parents / guardian before they

are allowed to return to their respective village or state.

However, he reminded that students who have left the campus will not be allowed to return unless they received an approval.

Masidi also said that the welfare of the students at the university is being looked after.

In addition to food assistance, the students also have access to counselling, targeted screening for Covid-19 and so on.
